



Information sheet on importation of pet food containing animal by-products

There are two ways of importing pet food into the European Union:

1. Regular importation

→ Goods can be imported on a permanent basis and given away / sold during the fair

Requirements:

- a. Company is listed
- b. Country is listed
- c. Correctly issued health certificate

If one of these conditions is not met

2. Importation with the import permission of the veterinary surgeon in charge

→ Goods can be imported on a temporary basis only and must be removed at the exhibitor's expense by DB Schenker after the fair has closed, it is not permitted to sell / give away goods

Requirements:

- a. Invoice showing all contents of shipment with Harmonized System (HS) codes
Exact description and health certificate number
- b. Packing list
- c. Exact description of goods, ("pet food" will not be accepted)
- d. Declaration of ingredients and how they were treated (boiled, raw, preserved)
- e. Correctly issued health certificate showing all necessary information
- f. Exact quantity of pet food (e.g. "5 cans à 0.3 kg")
- g. Utilization after fair: destruction

!!! Pet food must be shipped separately !!!

Copies of the import documents must be submitted **before** the goods are shipped.

Pet food must **arrive** at the airport / seaport at least **3 weeks before stand delivery**.

Products can be imported into Germany via the German seaport of **Hamburg** or airport of destination **Frankfurt (Master-Airway Bill / AWB)**.
The airport of destination on the prepared **House AWB** is **Nuremberg**. **The importation of pet foods containing animal by-products is not permitted via Nuremberg Airport.**
